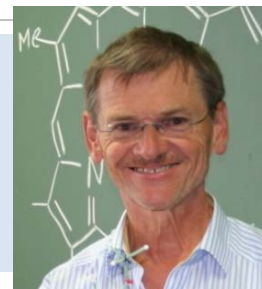

Organic chemistry, natural products chemistry, with analytical, synthetic, computational, and medicinal facets: Isolation, structural elucidation, total synthesis, biosynthesis, and pharmaceutical development of anti-infective and anti-tumoral agents from nature; hyphenated techniques like HPLC-MS/MS-NMR-ECD in combination with quantum-chemical ECD calculations; axially chiral biaryls; naphthylisoquinoline alkaloids; chiral porphyrins; materials inspired from nature
